

Best Grant Proposal on promoting Family Medicine practice among young faculty and residents of Community Medicine. 2021

Awarded by World NCD Federation during IAPSMCON21

World NCD Federation is a Professional Association, working for Global Health Agenda for Universal Health care for Non-communicable diseases (NCDs) which is accessible and acceptable to all and at a cost, the developed and developing countries can afford to maintain and sustain population wide and individual clinical NCD interventions.

Need for the grant

- Family practice has a major and potential role in prevention, management, improving compliance to lifestyle modification and treatment of noncommunicable diseases.
- Public health profession demands an increased association and exchange of ideas with multiple disciplines.
- Family practice among public health professionals is declining due to the shift in areas of interest and eventually there will be loss of acquired clinical skills and methods.
- To support this, and build family medicine skills a grant is being provided by the WNF in the platform of IAPSMCON 2021 to promote Family Medicine practice among young faculty and residents of Community Medicine working in the domain of non-communicable disease around the globe.

Priority areas & Grant Objectives

- 1. Promotion of family medicine practice among IAPSM members
- 2. To develop better skills in long & short case presentation among residents
- 3. Promotion of Comprehensive NCD management in primary & secondary health care facilities
- 4. Use of technology & digital health interventions
- 5. To meet the national health policy mandate as per national priorities

Guidelines for Grant and Eligibility

- A grant of Rs. 50,000/- in two installments
- Two Installments (Rs. 25000 after the selection of the proposal & Rs 25000 after the submission of the final report)
- Topic should be Promotion of Family medicine practice focusing on NCDs
- One Proposal per person is allowed, who shall be Principal Investigator
- Applicant should be a life member of either World NCD Federation or IAPSM
- Priority for young members (<40 years)
- The final report should be submitted by 31st January 2022

Main text

- Word Range- 1000-1500
- References- 10-15

Structure of the proposal

- Rationale for the practice
- Research Questions
- Methodology
- Data Management & statistical Plan
- Budget & Timeline

- Proposal Must be submitted via https://forms.gle/UHerQpNhkH7EWS8H6
- Last date for submission: 13th March 2021
- Presentation of 3 shortlisted proposals: 15.03.2021 and one shortlisted in IAPSMCON21 in Grant Session.

- The finalized report in the prescribed format must be submitted according to the committed timeline.
- If selected for grant, any publication arising out of the project must acknowledge the World NCD federation grant, and publication must be communicated to the office.

- Key research question(s) broken into PICO components (10)
- Inclusion/exclusion criteria (5)
- Literature searches for published/unpublished literature (10)
- Assessment Plan of methodological quality for individual studies (10)
- Data abstraction/data management, Data synthesis, analysis and presentation plan (10)
- Translational value for implementation (10)
- Budget & Timeline (5)
- Total Score=80 to be awarded by an expert panel
